1. ACHILLEA Ageratum Moonwalker
Sweet Nancy. Ideal for borders. Can be used as a cut or dried flower. Yellow flowers. 45-60cm 1lt

2. ACHILLEA Cerise Queen
Cerise flat heads. Strong grower. 60-75cm 1lt

3. ACHILLEA Cloth of Gold
Golden-yellow, flat heads, stiff stems. 60-90cm 1lt

4. ACHILLEA millefolium Colorado Yarrow. Mixture of colours, ranging from red to pink to apricot, occasionally white. 30-60cm 1lt BEST SELLER

5. ACHILLEA millefolium Lilac Beauty
Flat, plate-like flower heads held high above ferny foliage. Produces a profusion of rosy lilac flowers which fade slightly with age to a lavender pink. Flowers in summer. 60cm x 60cm 1lt 2lt

6. ACHILLEA millefolium Paprika
Cherry red flowers with gold centres. Flowers June to August. 60cm 1lt

7. ACHILLEA Salmon Beauty
Plentiful pale salmon-pink flower heads above neat mounds of aromatic, greyish-green, ferny foliage. Flowers early to late summer. 60-90cm x 30-45cm 1lt 2lt

8. ACHILLEA Summer Pastels
A mixture of pastel colours - pink, rose, carmine red, white and cream. 60cm 1lt BEST SELLER

9. ACHILLEA Terracotta
Clusters of dusky, orange flowers mature to yellow. Bearing attractive, light green, ferny foliage this perennial adds unique colour to the herbaceous border. Flowers in summer. 60cm x 60cm 1lt 2lt

15. ALYSSUM Montanum Gold
Long flowering evergreen carpet. Canary yellow flowers. 15-30cm 1lt

16. ALYSSUM Saxatile
Gold Dust/Golden Tuft. Yellow rock plant. Masses of flowers from April to June. 10-15cm 1lt

17. ANACYLUS Depressus
Mount Atlas Daisy. Small, white daisy-like flowers. Underside of petals are red. 60cm 1lt

18. ANEMONE Honorine Joboret
Single white flowers with a pink tinge on the reverse. Golden yellow stamens. Flowers from mid-summer. 75-150cm 1lt 2lt

19. ANEMONE Pamina
Attractive flowering perennial with deep pink, golden-centred flowers and elegant vine-like foliage. Flowers late summer. 80cm x 45cm 1lt 2lt BEST SELLER

20. ANEMONE Prinz Henrich
Clusters of pink, semi-double flowers. Strong spreading growth from July onwards. Ideal for borders. 60-90cm 1lt 2lt

21. ANEMONE Pulsatilla
Attractive violet, urn-shaped flowers. 25cm 1lt

22. ANEMONE Pulsatilla Vulgaris Red
Wine red, silky hairy flowers. Early-flowering. 25cm 1lt

Deep green foliage. White, daisy-like flowers from June to August. Scented. 10-45cm 1lt

33. ANTHEMIS Sancti-johannis
Good cut flower with large deep orange heads. Long flowering. 60cm 1lt

34. AQUILEGIA Alpina
Large, nodding, blue spurred flowers, on slender stems above finely-divided foliage. 30-35cm 1lt 2lt

35. AQUILEGIA Beidermeier
Densely clustered heads, mostly pastel colours. Semi-double flower heads, grey-green leaves. Suitable for alpine and rock gardens. 30-45cm 1lt

36. AQUILEGIA Blue Star
Columbine/Granny's Bonnet. Blue and white, long-spurred flowers with yellow centres. 60cm 1lt 2lt BEST SELLER

37. AQUILEGIA Crimson Star
Good border plant. Crimson flowers with white corolla. Flowers May to June. 50cm 1lt

38. AQUILEGIA Double Pleat

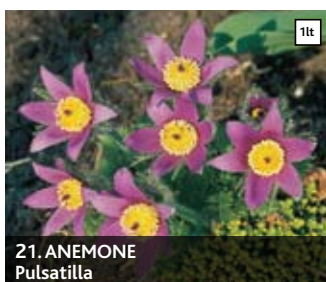

128. CAMPANULA White Clips

129. CAREX Buchanani

Known as Fox-Red Sedge. Red coloured for most of the year. Forms dense clumps. 60cm. 11t 21t

130. CAREX Comans Bronze
Brown-red clumps similar to Buchananii but more compact. 30cm 1lt 2lt BEST SELLER

131. CAREX Comans Green
Densely tufted evergreen perennial forming tussocks of hair-like yellow-green leaves. 35cm 1lt 2lt

132. CAREX Frosted Curls
Dense tufts of narrow arching silvery-green leaves, curled at tips. Excellent decorative plant for borders or containers. 20cm 1lt 2lt

133. CAREX Lurida
Large nodding flower spikes. Very showy. Dark green leaves. 40cm 1lt

134. CAREX Muskingumensis
Known as Palm Leaf Sedge. Grows well in wet areas, also sunny to semi-shade. Ornamental grass. 80cm high clumps. 1lt

135. CAREX Sylvatica
Wood Sedge. Tufted sedge with slender, furrowed, bright green leaves. Ideal for moist soils and shaded areas. 45cm 1lt

136. CARNATION Dwarf Vienna Mixed
Includes crimson, pale pink, rose, salmon, violet. Early flowering. 30cm 1lt

137. CARNATION Grenadin Mixed
Wide colour range. Well shaped blooms. Strong stems. 45cm 1lt

138. CARNATION Hardy Border
Medium to large double flowers. Green-blue foliage. Mixed colours. Ideal for cutting. 35-40cm 1lt BEST SELLER

139. CARNATION Hardy Border Crimson
Early flowering. Richly perfumed, rounded flower heads. Strong growth. 45cm 1lt

145. CENTAUREA Macrocephala
Great Golden Knapweed. Golden yellow thistle-like flowers. 120-180cm 1lt

146. CENTAUREA Montana
Perennial Cornflower. Deep blue flower heads with bushy habit. Flowers May-June. 50cm 1lt

147. CENTRANTHUS Alba Pura
Large border plant. Long flowering spell, May to September. 70cm 1lt 2lt

148. CENTRANTHUS Ruber
Red Valerian. Deep pink star shaped flowers on long stems. 70cm 1lt 2lt

149. CERASTIUM Tomentosum
Snow In Summer. Silvery-white foliage, abundant white flowers. 10cm 1lt

150. CERINTHE Major Purpurescens
Honeywort. Rich purple-blue nodding flowers on deep blue-green stems with very fleshy green leaves. May need protection from hard frost. 30-45cm 1lt BEST SELLER

151. CHAENORHINUM Blue Dream
Also known as Dwarf Snapdragon/ Small Toadflax, it bears attractive blue flowers in summer on spreading stems. 20cm 1lt

152. CHIASTOPHYLIUM Frosted Jade
Low-growing, thick variegated cream and green leaves. Creamy coloured flowers April to June. 15cm 1lt

153. CHIASTOPHYLLUM Oppositifolium
Spreading, evergreen perennial forming a dense mat of ovate, fleshy, pale green leaves. During spring. Long arching stems bear golden yellow bell-shaped flowers. 15cm 1lt

154. CHRYSANTHEMUM Action Bronze
Good selling green plant in spring with bronze flowers from late spring onwards. Pot or border plant. 30-35cm 1lt

155. CHRYSANTHEMUM Action Yellow
Strong growing 'pot garden mums.' Yellow, small headed flowers. Sells well as green plant in spring 25cm 1lt

156. CHRYSANTHEMUM Gala Burgundy
'Garden Mum' ideal for pot or border, burgundy red flowers. Good green plant sales in spring. 25cm 1lt

157. CHRYSANTHEMUM May Queen
Large white. Very early and free-flowering. 75cm 1lt

158. CHRYSANTHEMUM Silver Princess
Masses of white single flowers with yellow centres. 60cm 1lt BEST SELLER

159. CHRYSANTHEMUM Snow Lady
Small compact plant. Can be placed in containers. White flower heads. 30cm 1lt

160. CHRYSANTHEMUM Starburst
A compact bushy variety with bright green foliage. Bright white flowers with yellow centres. Flowers in summer. 80cm x 60cm 1lt

161. CHRYSANTHEMUM Weyrichii
Low growing plant, forming a spreading mound of dark green leaves, bearing short stems with sprays of white daisies in late summer to autumn. 15cm x 50cm 1lt

162. CHRYSANTHEMUM Wizard
Strong plant. White flowers from June onwards. Sells well as green plant. 25cm 1lt

163. CONVALLARIA Lily of the Valley
Tall, elegant stems with pale-foliage and small, beautiful, sweet-smelling flowers. Flowers April to May. 15-20cm 1lt

164. CONVULVULUS cneorum
Lance-shaped silver foliage makes a

perfect foil for the pure white flowers. Flowers late spring to early summer. 50cm x 80cm 2lt

165. COREOPSIS Early Sunrise
Tickseed. Early-flowering, golden-yellow, double flower heads on long stems above bushy, bright green foliage. 60cm 1lt 2lt BEST SELLER
